FY21-22 and FY22-23 Budget Process Updates

- Budget before Commission in February for approval and submitted to Mayor's Office on February 22, 2021
- At time of budget instructions, projections were for a deficit of \$411 million in FY21-22 and \$242 million in FY22-23
- Since departmental budget submissions, the City's fiscal outlook has dramatically been altered:
 - American Recover Plan Act Coronavirus Relief
 - Revenue improvements at six- and nine-month marks
 - Improvements to general fund balance in current fiscal year

FY21-22 and FY22-23 Budget Process Updates

- Updated budget outlook in March 2021 as part of the update to the City's financial plan showed a two-year \$653 million projected deficit revised to a \$22.9 million deficit over the two fiscal years
- Improvement is largely due to one-time Federal stimulus
- Wage deferral triggers no longer in effect
- Significant structural deficits still projected over the next five fiscal years, consistent with previous projects but with slight improvements

Community Paramedicine

- Significant investment in expansion of SFFD's Community Paramedicine Division:
 - EMS-6 Continuation of COVID functions post-pandemic
 - Expansion of Street Crisis Response Team (SCRT)
 - Creation of Street Wellness Response Team (SWRT) to assist with well-being checks and other call types
 - Implementation of Street Opioid Response Team (SORT) to respond to opioid calls
 - Four administrative and management support positions to assist with program expansion

Fleet/Equipment

- As the current fiscal year 2020-21 marks the end of the Fire Department's original five-year fleet and equipment replacement plan, the Mayor's Office has committed to a new five-year plan, with a minimum investment of \$3.5 million a year in equipment allocation
- Additional one-time funds were allocated in the first budget year, for a total allocation of approximately **\$6.5** million

 - Upgrade of a positions to Assistant Deputy Chief for oversight and management of the Department's Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)
 - Funded by City's Reinvestment Initiative
- Allocation for acquisition of SF Port land for Training Facility
- Other allocations for position upgrades and substitutions
