




More Information

Earthquake Safety and Emergency Response (ESER) is San Francisco's bond program to strategically address critical public safety needs in the City. The program identifies seismic improvements and upgrades to City-owned facilities that are needed to help safeguard San Francisco.

The City and County of San Francisco is proposing the third phase of the ESER bond program for the March 2020 ballot. ESER 2020 will continue the work of the previous two ESER bonds that were overwhelmingly approved by voters in 2010 and 2014.

ESER 2010 and 2014 funded improvements to neighborhood fire stations, district police stations and the Emergency Firefighting Water System. They also funded comprehensive renovations to facilities, such as the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner and Fire Station No. 36 (Civic Center) as well as the construction of new facilities that include, the Police Department Headquarters, the Motorcycle Police and Crime Lab facility and Fire Station No. 5 (Fillmore District).
