2. CASE NO. 2015-06: CONTINUATION OF DELIBERATIONS ON VERIFIED COMPLAINT FILED WITH THE COMMISSION BY CHIEF OF DEPARTMENT [Discussion and possible action]

On December 9, 2015, Chief of Department Joanne Hayes-White filed a verified complaint with the Commission against member for a non-punitive medical separation.

The Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing in the above case on March 1, 2016. At the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing, the Commission began deliberations but did not reach a decision and will now continue deliberating.

This case may be heard in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code Section 54957(b) and San Francisco Administrative Code Section 67.10(b).

Vice President Cleaveland made a motion to hold deliberations in Closed Session. Commissioner Hardeman seconded, and the motion was unanimously approved. (4-0; Cleaveland, Covington, Nakajo, Hardeman,)

By a unanimous vote of Commissioners present (4-0: Commissioners Covington, Cleaveland, Nakajo, Hardeman), the Commission accepted the Chief of Department's recommendation of a non-punitive medical separation of the member from the department.
