Goals for the Public

- To provide a live action re-creation of how the SFFD operated from the late 1800's with horse drawn steam fire pumpers, hose wagons, ladder trucks to motorized equipment of the 1900's
- To provide an area for antique and mid-modern fire apparatus to be displayed
- To provide SFFD information on Fire Prevention, NERT, Training, Recruitment, etc. with individual booths
- To provide for the Fire Reserve to display the 5 inch above ground emergency water supply unit
- To provide for additional adjustments as necessary

A parade of all antique apparatus will be conducted on Saturday through the Fisherman's Wharf area as shown in a later slide.

Units finishing the parade will be either on stationary public display or will be used in live action events on the closed Little Embarcadero St. during the day.

Sunday will provide the same events as Saturday with the exception of the parade.

During both days, a water display from the SFFD Fireboat will be provided on the bay IFO the viewing location. Bleachers will be erected in the parking lot shown in a later slide.
