The Homeland Security Division (HS1) started because of the Federal Grant funding that San Francisco received to coordinate against terrorism threats.

The Assistant Deputy Chief of Homeland Security is responsible for coordinating many efforts. A large number are in cooperation with other SFFD Divisions.

Mutual Aid/Operational Area Coordinator:

All fire Departments participate in a system in which aid can be provided to outside jurisdictions experiencing an emergency that exceeds their capability. This is seen most often in our firefighters deploying to the front lines to fight fires during fire season. There is also a robust management system – Incident Management Team – operating to lead efforts, write plans based on operational need, and secure/determine distribution of resources. HS1 works closely with SFFD Mutual Aid Operational Area Coordinator in the development of qualified members for the local and deployable IMT.

EMS – Emergency Medical Services:

HS1 works closely with EMS staff for coordinating EMS assets at Special events for producing the written plans that guide our response and provides a common operating picture. For planned events, this is called the Event Action Plan (EAP) and for Active disasters it is an Incident Action Plan (IAP). HS1 also works with EMS staff to plan the EMS section in the SFFD Disaster Plan.

Training & Operations:

HS1 works with the training division in support of determining training needs for the development of HazMat qualified members, IMT training, and Disaster Drills. HS1 also works closely with SFFD Operations in development of EAP/IAP, and in development of writing field operations section of the Disaster Plan.

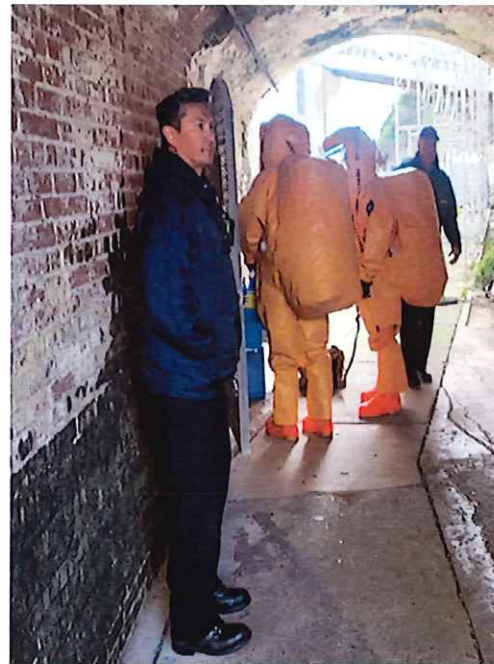
HazMat:

HS1 coordinates with the HazMat section on participation in outside agency drills. This can include drills with the 95th Civil Support team and California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES). HS1 is also a bridge between SFFD HazMat and two grant streams, the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) and Securing the Cities (STC) for funding, training, and exercises.

Additional Entities:

Liaison to outside agencies to include Department of Emergency Management (DEM), NCRIC, FBI, FEMA, United States Secret Service (USSS) and CalOES Emergency Management.

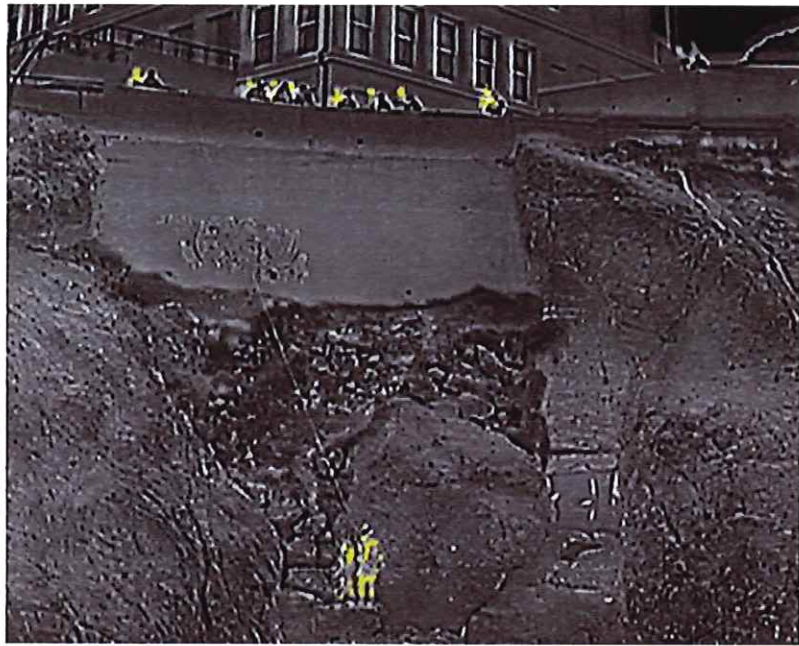

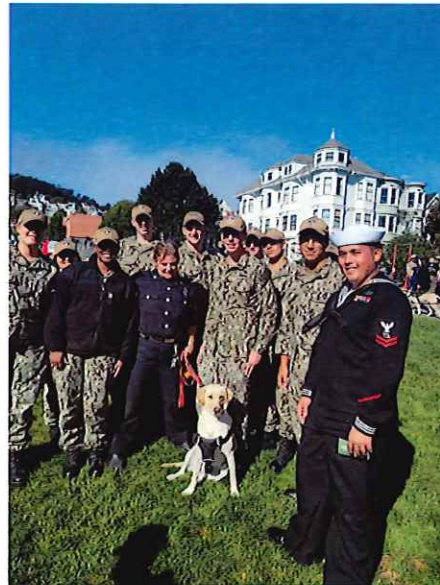

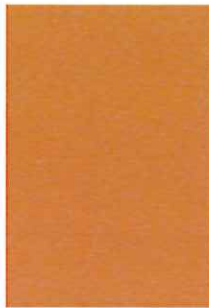
