## **RESOLUTION 2025-02**

## RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZE THE SAN FRANCISCO FIRE DEPARTMENT TO RETROACTIVELY APPROVE THE AMENDMENT OF A REVENUE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND THE PRESIDIO TRUST FOR PROVIDING FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES TO PORTIONS OF THE PRESIDIO UNDER THE TRUST'S JURISDICTION FOR AN ADDITIONAL TEN YEARS

WHEREAS, the Presidio Trust is a wholly owned United States government corporation established to manage the central interior and developed space of the Presidio. On October 1, 2010, the San Francisco Fire Department and the Presidio Trust entered into a cooperative agreement for the Fire Department to provide fire and emergency medical services to the areas of the Presidio under the Trust's jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the principal objective of the cooperative agreement was to benefit the public by implementing a long-term plan for providing fire and emergency medical response and services to the areas of the Presidio under the Trust's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, since the start of the agreement, the San Francisco Fire Department and the Presidio Trust have established an extremely strong working relationship and have become public safety partners to improve overall emergency response to the Presidio and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, the original term of the agreement was a ten-year initial term through September 30, 2020, and included three options to extend the agreement for five years each extension; and

WHEREAS, due to the pandemic and other administrative delays, the first extension was never formally executed; and

WHEREAS, despite the passing of the expiration date of the original term, the Fire Department and Presidio Trust have continued under the terms of the Original

Agreement, which set forth the Fire Department's compensation and scope of services provided; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department and the Presidio Trust wish to amend the original agreement by exercising the first two extensions of the original agreement, which will extend the term by ten years, from October 1, 2020, to September 30, 2030; and, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Fire Commission recommends the Board of Supervisors retroactively approve the amendment of the agreement between the Fire Department and Presidio Trust to extend the term through September 30, 2030.
