Applications for cohort 10 closed on July 11th with an overwhelming 117 potential student submittals. We only have 25 seats.

9910 Internships

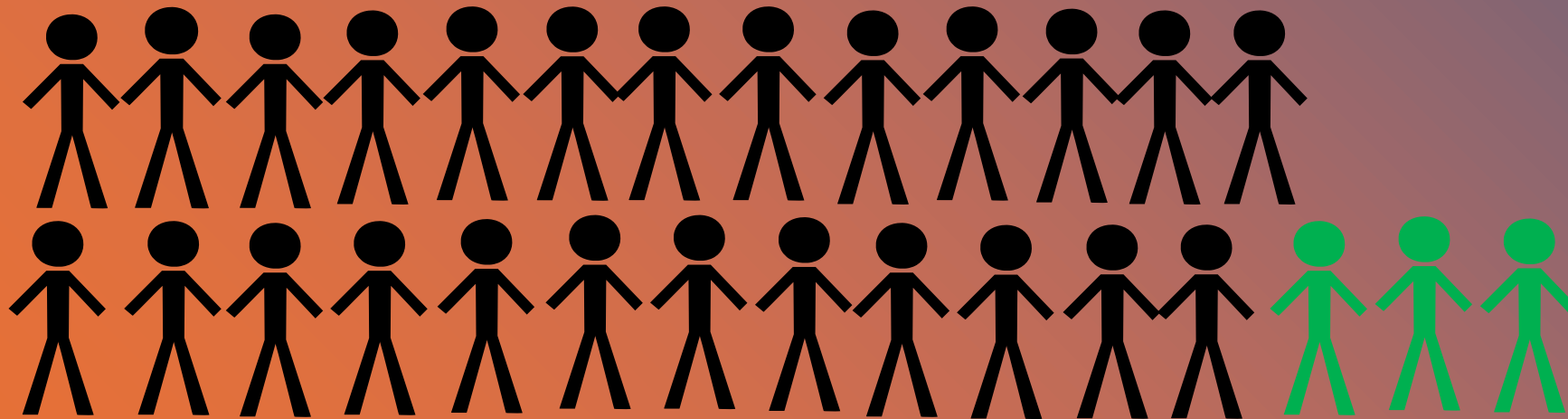


- Since our inception 65 students have participated in the much needed 9910 internship program.

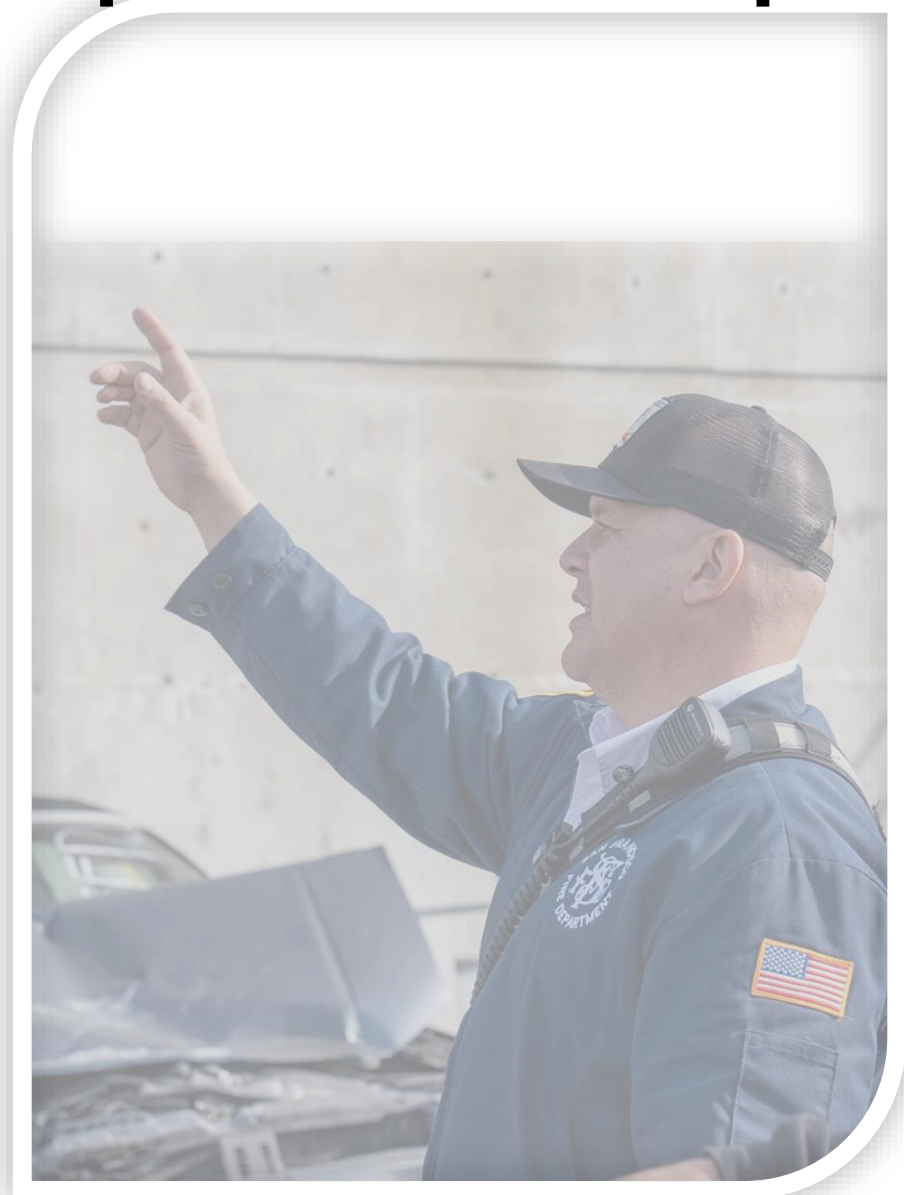
