

- A two year Public Service Academy featuring a year of Criminal Justice and a year of Fire Science/EMT curriculum

- SFFD Firefighters, Paramedics and CCSF staff meet with CTE to discuss the possibility of a Public Service Academy
- SFFD Firefighters, Paramedics, CCSF staff and CTE visit the successful programs at Berkeley High and Eden Area ROP in Hayward
- Jon Baxter meets interested school principals
- Public Service Academy starts with 1st year Criminal Justice at John O'Connell High School



Next Steps

- Propose to the broader SFFD and identify a structure for firefighters and paramedics to participate
- Write curriculum and have it approved by UC Doorways
- Work with CCSF staff to identify appropriate dual enrollment courses/Instructors
