The Department welcomes the participation of other emergency service apparatus for the Funeral Service on Friday. We respectfully request that apparatus participation be limited to Friday only.

All apparatus are welcome to participate in the procession from the church to the cemetery following the funeral service. For agencies that would prefer not to participate in the procession, a reception will be held in the hall below the church. Staging locations will be different for those participating in the procession vs. those who will be staying for the reception. More information will follow regarding specifics. Please keep in mind that those participating in the procession, will not be able to return to attend the reception at the church.

For agencies planning to arrive on Thursday evening, a designated area for Apparatus parking has been secured at Pier 50, in the South of Market Area in San Francisco (A detailed map will follow). Pier 50 will be accessible beginning at 1600 hours on Thursday, June 9, 2011.

Please note, if your agency will be staying at the Hilton Fisherman's Wharf (2620 Jones Street), a secure parking lot for apparatus has been obtained at the Longshoremen's Hall at 400 North Point Street. For assistance with lodging, please contact Local 798 at 415-621-7103.

**All apparatus are directed to report to procession staging at 1030 hours on Friday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, on Divisadero Street at Geary Boulevard. Staging will take place on both sides of Divisadero (North & South Directions) facing Geary Blvd. Staging Area Manager is Battalion Chief Bryan Rubenstein.
