**113th Anniversary of the
Great San Francisco Earthquake and Fire of 1906**

Annual *Lotta's Fountain* and *Golden Hydrant Painting* Commemoration Events

On Thursday, April 18, 2019, the San Francisco Fire Department, along with other early risers, will be commemorating the 113th anniversary of the Great Earthquake and Fire of 1906 at an annual commemoration ceremony being held at the historic *Lotta's Fountain* in downtown San Francisco.

The event, which begins precisely at 5:12 AM, the exact time the 1906 earthquake struck the sleeping city of San Francisco is, “the time that we San Franciscans commemorate those who suffered great losses and to celebrate the spirit and resolve of the people of San Francisco who overcame the devastation of that historical day and rebuilt this great City” said Fire Chief Joanne Hayes-White. “This is also a time to educate and remind all people of the importance of disaster preparedness.”

After the commemoration ceremony at *Lotta's Fountain*, a procession will be made to the famous golden fire hydrant, on the corner of 20th and Church streets, for the annual re-painting ceremony. The celebrated fire hydrant is said to have been the sole source of water, used by thousands of volunteers, responsible for saving the south side of the Mission District during the aftermath of the 1906 earthquake.

A Disaster Preparedness Safety Fair and Mobile Command Rally will be held to commemorate the 113th anniversary of the Great Quake. This is a free mobile communications/command vehicle demonstration and educational event for public safety personnel and the public held on Thursday April 18th 9AM to 4PM. The event is in San Francisco at Oracle Park (formerly AT&T Park), Parking Lot A, 3rd Street @ Mission Rock St. just south of the ballpark.
