In addition to standing demonstrations of mobile units, **classroom presentations** will be offered, including planned coverage of the 1906 earthquake relative to today's earthquake preparedness (this date is the 112th anniversary of the 1906 quake), and coverage of the California wildfires of 2017.

We expect 25-30 MCCs to be on display, from a variety of disciplines and organizations including both state-of-the-art commercial units as well as DIY vehicles, in a myriad of sizes, shapes, and configurations.
